Åkersjön Bike Park

They rent out 7 fatbikes, you can rent them for a full or half day to ride scooter trails or on the road. Or you can also hire them to go down the mountain but it is 30 minutes after the slopes are closed for skiers or by appointment (there is no lighting in the ski slope so it is currently only possible as long as it is daylight).

In the summer we have downhill bikes that you can also rent to go downhill on 2 different courses one green and one red (there are plans to add a short black section).

When cycling downhill there is an obligation to wear protection which can also be rented.


Ice hockey rink


Also show how you can read/learn to interact with a horse.

The bird tower in Mussjön

Mussjön with its bird tower is one of Jämtland's most interesting birding locations.

Parts of the lake are therefore a bird protection area. In the northern parts, on Mussjönäset, the county administration has had a bird tower built. In the area there is an extensive trend every spring. A special observation hut has therefore been built near the place where the cranes dance.

Mussjön has fantastic bird life and has been a bird protection area since 1975. Here you have the opportunity to see ducks, cranes, whooper swans, great loons and many other species. If the weather is bad, you can go inside the tower where there is a stove, bench and opening windows.

Directions: To find the bird protection area, drive from Änge towards Almåsa. The area is about 1.5 km by car from ICA, on the left. Easy hike, about 2 km from the parking lot down to the lake and the tower. Follow the blue markings. The trail is partly wet, so please wear boots.



Kluks bowlinghall


A short drive from the cottage you can play bowling, at kluk's local community center.





Bredbyen swimming area

Stone carvings

On the rock slab in the middle of the flowing water there are three moose. One of these is carved life-size and is the largest single figure carving in Sweden.

During the Stone Age, 7000 years ago, there was a so-called captive population that periodically stayed next to Lake Gärdesjön. They subsisted on hunting, fishing and what nature otherwise provided.


Today we can see the traces they left behind in the form of rock carvings at Gärdeforsen. On the rock slab in the middle of the flowing water there are three moose. One of these is carved life-size and is the largest single figure carving in Sweden. At the south shore of the flowing water there are several motifs. One of these is a figure of a moose and a track stamp of a moose. A few meters away are ten human footprints leading up to an elk, which is interpreted as a hunting scene. Next to it are four moose track marks and a carving that has been interpreted as a human figure.

Coffee break after the visit? During the summer, Café Své is open and is located nearby. There you can enjoy delicious coffee while being treated to an incredibly beautiful view.

The crystal mine in Olden

An awesome destination. The rock crystals in the Olden mine are at least 400 million years old. There are also cozy cafés nearby! The rocks at the mine is described as a pegmatite with drusen rooms of rock crystals and decimetre-wide banks of graphite. During World War II 1942-1946, rock crystal was mined in the mine which was used in the optical and telecommunication industry. At Olden's crystal mine, about ten people worked up at the mine. In addition, a number of people down in the village were employed to wash the crystals and boil them in lye and hydrochloric acid before they were sent to the company's facility in Stockholm for further processing.

The annual production of rock crystal at the mine averaged 2.5 tonnes. The largest crystals were 2-3 dm and a large part was 5-6 cm in diameter. The crystals from Olden were used partly for electrical purposes and partly for jewellery making. A large part of the crystals were sent to Germany for grinding. When the war was over and cross-border trade started again, the need for rock crystal could be covered with cheaper imported crystal and mining at the mine in Olden was stopped. Nowadays, no rock crystal is mined, but a lot remains.

If you are coming from Rönnöfors, drive through the village of Olden and near Olden's Bystuga you will see a sign with reference to the Crystal Mine, a road up to the right. You can park quite close, it takes about 5-10 minutes to walk.

Don't miss to swing by Café Häma n' David in Rönnöfors, here you can have a coffee in a cozy old school, decorated in a contemporary way, which for some can certainly bring back childhood memories.



Ristafallet!

Ristafallet is a waterfall in the parish of Undersåker in western Jämtland and is one of Sweden's largest falls. The fall is located along the Indalsälven, 17 kilometers east of Åre, just under a kilometer from the E14 and a campsite is immediately adjacent to the fall. It is 355 meters above sea level.

A secluded, wooded island divides the falls into two parts, the northern and the southern part. The island screens off the halves of the falls, so that the northern half cannot be seen from the southern shore and vice versa. The whole area has the shape of a giant amphitheater. The fall is a total of approximately 50 m wide, 14 m high and the flow is between 100 and 400 m³/s, depending on the season. Both upstream and downstream of the fall there is sport fishing mainly for trout, and downstream also grayling. Along the hiking trail on the northern river bank downstream of Ristafallet is Olav's spring, which is believed to have quenched the thirst of medieval pilgrims on their journey to Olav the Saint's grave in Nidaros (Trondheim). The Rista fall and the nature surrounding the fall are considered a protected natural area, protected according to Swedish law. In the humid environment of Ristafallet, a special fauna thrives with special lichens, plants and animals.

You will reach the waterfall after about 40 minutes drive from the cabins.

Tännforsen!

The fall forms part of the Indal River and connects the lakes Tännsjön (above the fall) and Öster-Noren (below the fall). The amount of water that rushes forward varies greatly between seasons. In a normal year, the water flow reaches its peak in the second half of May, when 200–400 cubic meters of water rush over the neck of the falls every second. At least between December and February, Tännforsen is instead covered by an ice sheet. The largest water flow measured during the 20th century is over 800 cubic meters per second. It was during the spring flood of 1995.

Visitors can follow a marked walking tour that goes around Tännforsen. The trail takes about half an hour to walk and is about 1 kilometer long. During the summer season, it is also possible to go on guided hiking tours.
